

MAKE A FLOWER SUN CATCHER

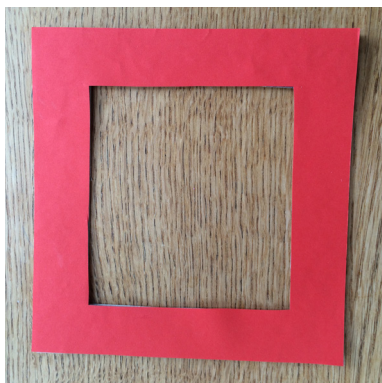
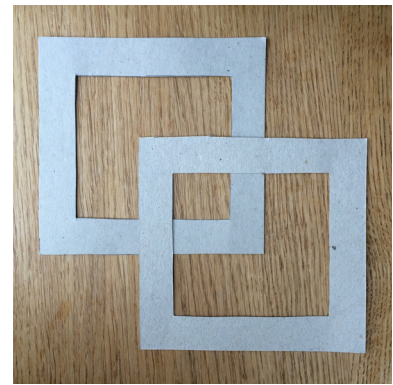
WHAT YOU WILL NEED

1. An old cardboard box (you could use a cereal box if you are painting the frame)
2. Scissors
3. Cellophane (you can get this from a hobbycraft shop) / or use household Clingfilm
4. Clear Glue
5. Selection of flowers

STEP 1

Cut a frame out of the old cardboard boxes. You will need two square pieces with a square hole in the middle.

NB: ask a grown up to help with cutting out.
If you fancy being a bit different cut a round hole.



STEP 2

Decorate your frame. You could use fancy wrapping paper or paint it or if you are using white card you can draw your favourite pictures on it.

STEP 3

Use the cellophane to wrap that side of the frame that will be the back of the frame and glue.

Lay your flowers petals facing onto the cellophane (it might be easier to press your flowers first between two books) to get the right look.



STEP 4

Cover the back with cellophane then glue the other cardboard to create your frame. You can paint your frame any colour we loved matching our frame with the colour of the flowers.

STEP 5

To make these beautiful panels gleam string them together and hang from your window to let the sun shine through the panel creating pretty shadows across your room.

Top Tip Perfect gift and ideal as summer activity when you've been out for a walk. Remember, don't pick other people's flowers and always check with mum if she minds you picking flowers out of your garden.
